Ivan Pictet, former Senior Banker at Pictet & Cie, the largest private bank founded in 1805 in Geneva, Switzerland. Ivan spoke to the AIC Club on September 12,2014, in his capacity as President of the Fondation pour Genève : on. « Is Geneva Still Unique on the World Stage ». Ivan retired in 2010, but far from retiring, he is one of the foremost advocates for « Genève International », Geneva's unique role as the Ambassador for Switzerland abroad

Ivan Pictet, not only reaffirmed the vital role of Geneva on the world stage, being the host city for many important international organisations, the Human Rights Council; the Organisation for Trade and Commerce; the World Health Organisation (WHO), the International Labour Organisation (ILO), the World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO), and many others, without forgetting that Geneva is the home of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC). Many do not realise that the majority of international laws that manage the world's nations policies, eminate from these international institutions based in Geneva.

Ivan Pictet will not only continue to promote Geneva's continuing prominent role in the world abroad, but also in Switzerland, where in April 2015, to celebrate the 200 Years since Geneva's adhesion to the Swiss Confederation, he will cross 26 cantons with a giant bus painted by Zep, father of Titeuf, to present to all of Switzerland, the vital role of Geneva in the world of international diplomacy and institutions.

Ivan Pictet is currently also President of the Investment Committee of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund ; Chairman of the Board of Directors of PSA International SA ; and President of « Fondation Pictet pour le Développement ».
