## THE THREE MAJORS OF THE GRAND SLAM

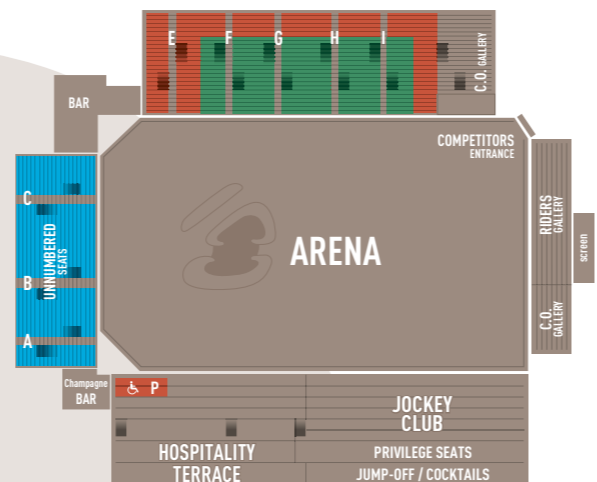
